

After graduating with a degree in philosophy from Milan's State University, **Erica Arosio** reported on culture and entertainment for the magazine *Gioia*. For many years she covered film for Radio Popolare, and she also wrote a biography of Marilyn Monroe (1989). She is a contributor to *la Repubblica*, *Il Giorno*, *Cineforum* and *Rockerilla*, among others. In 2012 she published her first novel, *L'uomo sbagliato*.

For over thirty years, **Giorgio Maimone** was the managing editor of **Sole 24 Ore** and the guiding spirit behind *Bielle*, a website devoted to songwriters. He worked in theater, ran the first free radio station for Milan's leftists, Radio Canale 96, and collaborated with the Mediaset television channels, devising and writing its programs. Maimone founded the songwriting web portal *La Brigata Lolli*. He writes book and film reviews, and started working with Erica Arosio when he was the editor of her novel *L'uomo sbagliato*.

Together with Erica Arosio, Maimone created the characters of Greta and Marlon and the two co-wrote *Vertigine: l'ombra oscura del passato* (2013), *L'amour Gourmet* (2014) and *Non mi dire chi sei. Il caso Giuditta*.
